 - b. Grants (Navamy Srikanth)
 - i. Overview: Teachers brought lots of great ideas for grants. \$9,500 for the year. The HSC discussed all grants in detail. Some discussion around Cooking and why the requests for grant money is typically very high. Todd does support cooking with his own money as well. Also, discussion around request for shed for Music. It is very expensive but HSC recognizes it is important and wants to support Mr Kay in getting one. Discussed how much money Music Boosters currently has to put towards the shed vs how much they need. This isn't clear yet because they haven't finished fundraising this year and they still have big events to cover (ie Disneyland). Grant money needs to be used in the year it is given so music can't roll grant money over into the next FY as savings. The current amount needed would deplete grant funds available.
