 - Boosters – increased from \$98K to \$120K, Cheer revenue of \$2,727, Music revenue of \$6,055, Percussion revenue \$3,000, Sports revenue \$23,201, HSC cash down. Total net income for blast \$10K+, 135% of budget. Paid bookfair expenses, spent \$1,300 on cooking supplies, etc.

 - Activities – new noontime activities, turkey trot, Halloween contest went well. Dance on 12/13, working on decorations, new music, promoting Instagram, snapchat account, kindness week planning.

5. New Business
 - Fall 2019 Grant Proposals – 7 grant requests total. All grants approved.
 - PLC (Parent Leadership Council) Report – Met on 10/8, over 100 teachers in the district attended professional development. After school programs discussed, good source of revenue. Chrome books have been rolled out to 5th graders. When they start 6th grade, plan is to give them the same chrome book, useful life is 4 years, so by the end of 8th grade, these students may be able to keep them. Universal design for learning, instruction is differentiated, aim for difficult pins first.
